

TIM REBERS

Tim returns to CBINT for a fifth concert; he played Perchik in *Fiddler* (2016), the title role in *King David* (2017), a soloist in the Bernstein Celebration (2018), and a 'parisian' brother in *Joseph* (2019). He is thrilled to be working with Hazzan Stein on this celebration of Stephen Sondheim's works.

Tim is a multi-faceted artist: singer/actor, conductor, director, composer/arranger, and teacher. He has performed in operas, musicals, plays, concerts, and recitals throughout the greater Milwaukee area and beyond. Tim has performed frequently with Skylight Music Theatre and Milwaukee Opera Theatre (For their co-production of *Ruddigore* in early 2020, he was music director, conductor, actor/singer, and he re-arranged the score into a mostly a cappella show). Tim has also music directed and conducted shows for Wisconsin Lutheran College and Menomonee Falls High School.

Tim is the Artistic Director of Brew City Opera; he arranged, orchestrated, conducted, and sang in *L'ultima Canzone* a radio-drama style show BCO created and released for free (listen at Brewcityopera.com). As one third of Tenors MKE (alongside Andrew Varela and Tommy Hahn; Maggie Rebers, accompanist) Tim sings a wide range of styles. As a composer, Tim's full length opera, "Thank You. NEXT!" premiered in 2016, and he completed two short sci-fi operas in 2020. He performs regularly with his wife, Maggie (the best art song accompanist he knows) and maintains a small private teaching studio.



Anne Van Deusen

Anne Van Deusen loves creating music and storytelling whenever and wherever possible. This year, she's thrilled to be back at CBINT, with great singers, solid instrumentalists, and Sondheim. Anne has over twenty-five years of experience as music director, vocal coach, production accompanist and pit musician. She has worked with many professional and community organizations,

including Skylight Music Theatre, Milwaukee Opera Theatre, Florentine Opera, Milwaukee Ballet, In Tandem, Off the Wall and Waukesha Civic. Favorite projects include: Violet, Powder Her Face, Tosca, The Snow Dragon, El Cimarrón, Three Postcards and Sunday in the Park with George. In addition to her work in the theatre world, she is the Director of Music Ministries at Our Lady of Lourdes Catholic Church in Milwaukee.



HAZZAN JEREMY STEIN

Hazzan Jeremy Stein joined Congregation Beth Israel Ner Tamid in July of 2009. A native of Pawtucket, Rhode Island, he studied flute and arranging at Berklee College of Music in Boston, Massachusetts. After graduating, he toured with his jazz/rock band Flutopia, played on film scores, composed radio jingles, and performed at countless Jewish weddings. In 2009, Hazzan Stein

graduated from the H. L. Miller Cantorial School and College of Jewish Music at the Jewish Theological Seminary. At JTS, he was awarded the Max and Sol Feld Prize in composition two consecutive years. Hazzan Stein's performances have taken him to such stages as Carnegie Hall and the Original House of Blues in Boston. He has performed many times with The Zamir Choral Foundation, sharing the stage with perennial Jewish performers Theodore Bikel and Debbie Friedman.

Hazzan Stein is a passionate, dedicated teacher and enjoys working with congregants of all ages. He is a regular volunteer at the Milwaukee Jewish Home and Care Center, serenading Milwaukee's seniors with classics from Israel, Yiddish theater, and the Great American Songbook. In 2019, Hazzan Stein led the Cantors Assembly solidarity mission and recording project celebrating 100 Years of the Abayudaya Jewish community of Uganda, and he has continued to collaborate on this project with other cantors as well as his wife and favorite musicologist, Amanda Ruppenthal Stein. He is the proud Abba of Mirit, Hadas, and Yishai Bear.


